SUPER TUESDAY OVERVIEW

The Annual Super Tuesday Conference is a program designed to host business owners and professional women, men and students from throughout the metro Atlanta community. In 1984, under the leadership of Alice White Bussey, the Women In Business Committee of the Atlanta Business League created this forum to interact and raise awareness of African-American women business owners and professionals.

At that time the Women In Business Committee solicited the support of The Honorable Shirley Franklin who was then the Chief Operating Officer for the City of Atlanta and former Fulton County Commissioner Michael Lomax to support the idea of on-site certification for women business owners, thereby bringing new resources for corporations and federal, state and local governments. Being a woman and understanding the challenges faced by women in business, Ms. Franklin was responsible for identifying a \$5,000 grant to support the Women in Business Committee for a subsequent Super Tuesday program.

THE HONORABLE STACEY ABRAMS

Author, Politician, Attorney Voting Rights Advocate

Stacey Abrams is a political leader, business owner and New York Times bestselling author. A tax attorney by training, Abrams served eleven years in the Georgia House of Representatives, seven as Minority Leader, and became the Democratic nominee for governor of Georgia in 2018 and 2022. Over the course of her career, she has launched multiple organizations devoted to democracy protection, voter engagement, tackling social issues, and building a more equitable future in the South. Committed to the pursuit of equity, she works to break barriers for young people, people of color and the marginalized through her work in the public, nonprofit and corporate sectors.

She currently serves as the Ronald W. Walters Endowed Chair for Race and Black Politics at Howard University and is a senior counsel to Rewiring America. Abrams is also the CEO of Sage Works Productions, Inc., an entertainment production company.

Abrams sits on both nonprofit and corporate boards, and she is a lifetime member of the Council on Foreign Relations. She has received degrees from Spelman College, the LBJ School of Public Affairs at the University of Texas, and Yale Law School.

AZIRA G. HILL
Founder
Atlanta Symphony Orchestra

Born in Cuba, Azira G. Hill came to the United States to attend Boyland Haven boarding school in Jacksonville, Florida. She later attended Bethune Cookman College and Grady Memorial Hospital School of Nursing. While at Grady, she worked as a staff nurse and clinical instructor. Azira returned to Cuba to marry her husband, Jesse Hill in 1955 in Holguin, Cuba.

A lover of music, inspired by her large musical family in Cuba Azira was energized to volunteer at the Atlanta Symphony Orchestra. After becoming a member of the Atlanta Symphony Associates (ASA) she became an Atlanta Symphony Board member. From that engagement grew the vision to establish a program to 'change the face of the symphony orchestra' and The Action Committee for Audience Development in the Black Community was formed.

In September of 1993, Azira and members of the Atlanta community of all ethnicities selected ten black young musicians from over 100 applicants. These youth emerged as members of the ASO's Talent Development Program (TDP). Under her leadership, the TDP has become a model among other arts organizations nationwide to curate diverse musicianship and has helped nurture nearly 100 young musicians to earn slots at top music schools, such as The Juilliard School, Curtis Institute of Music, Manhattan School of Music and the Peabody Institution, and pursue careers in orchestras, teaching and performance. In 1999, the Azira G. Hill scholarship was established to provide financial assistance for students to attend summer programs.

Key to developing these young classical musicians is Azira's model of mentorship, which goes beyond private lessons and audition preparation to include family education, life skills training and financial assistance for intensive summer music programs.

Her involvement and affiliations span a wide spectrum of activities, including the following boards: Founder of the Atlanta Symphony Orchestra's Talent Development Program, former member of the Center for Puppetry Arts board, Southeastern Flower Show, Black Women's Agenda, former member of the Board of Literary Action board, St. Joseph Mercy Care, Urban League Guild, and Planned Parenthood. She is a member of Atlanta Quettes, Circle – Lets, Inc., and the Inquirer's Literary Club. She is a member of Big Bethel A.M.E. Church, a Golden Heritage Life Member of the NAACP, Life Member of the National Association of School Nurses, a charter member of Azalea City (GA) Chapter The Links, Incorporated and a Life Member of the National Council of Negro Women.
